Any of the classes that are designated by 600L, 500L or 600F, regardless of whether they are Pro or Junior or anything between, are stock sleds. The short skis they are allowed to run give them a slightly different look than the consumer sleds. The CHAMP, FORMULA and SPRINT classes are allowed numerous chassis modifications along with varying degrees of engine modifications depending on the class.

Any number designation in a race class refers to the maximum cubic centimeter or cc displacement of the engine allowed in that class.

In the JR BOYS or GIRLS classes the age of the driver allowed in that specific class is included in the heading.

The JR NOVICE 10-13 CHAMP 380 FAN is a new class started last year. It allows the junior riders to use a CHAMP chassis with a 380 FAN stock motor. The idea is to give these riders a chance to run CHAMP chassis before they make the jump to the PRO classes.

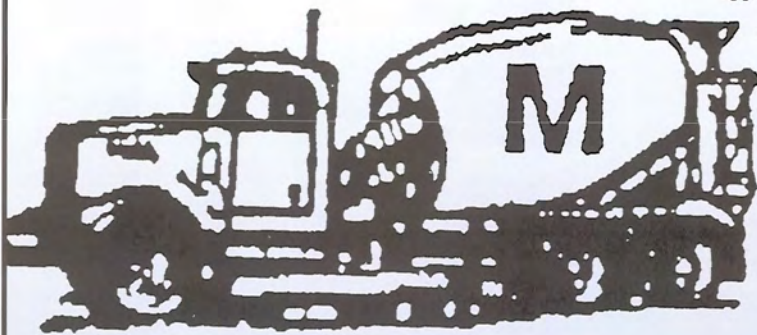

A FANTASTIC RACETRACK!

Did you ever wonder how the great race complex that hosts the CPTC races came to be?

The first CPTC was held in 1963 and was held at the Beausejour High School yard. There was also a cross-country portion. The next two years were held at Colmer's Park, east of Beausejour, on the Brokenhead River. After that, all the races were held in the town on a man-made oval track in the open fields adjacent to the town.

By 1972, constructing a completely new snow bank walled oval track was becoming a monumental task. The Board of Directors looked to construct a permanent facility. One of the local volunteers, Chuck Reis, was asked to become the President of CPTC, and he accepted, with the condition that he could have a 2-year term and that the Board make an attempt at establishing a permanent track.

With this mandate, the Board Members looked at several sites within the Beausejour area. Land that was available and satisfactory, that were considered, included a site 2 miles west of town on PR 215, the east side of 1st Street North on the corner of Hwy. 44 and 1st Street, and also the north east corner of the Beausejour town section. All these were rejected in favor of the present site.

The present site was selected due to its proximity to the town, easy highway access and few trees and obstacles to clean. The owners at the time, the Kaatz brothers, gave the CPTC a very reasonable price for 60 acres, with an option for the next year on 20 more acres to the north.

The Board of Directors acted without hesitation, even though each of the members had to sign a personal note at the bank to cover the cost of purchase!

So the permanent site was born! Limited design layout was discussed, and consultation was held about track design. Bob Eastman and Larry Rugland at Polaris recommended a large oval, flat track, very wide with raised banks. Motorcycle drivers and car drivers were also consulted. Off-track starting gates were a unique feature.

In the mid-summer of 1973, construction was begun. John Wenzoski Construction of Beausejour donated his equipment and CPTC paid wages and fuel. The earthen banks were constructed in record time and the track was reality! Perimeter fencing was installed with volunteer labour and donated concrete from Al Meisner Ltd. Local volunteers built concession booths and washroom facilities, some of which are still in use today.

The Board of Directors had very ambitious plans for the new facility. Phase I was the initial construction of the track, building and parking for 10,000 vehicles. This was completed in the autumn of 1973. Phase II was to include an administration building, additional concession and washroom facilities, TV towers for camera use and telephone service. Phase III was to see a permanent chain link fence on the banks for spectator safety, and a control tower for officials and landscaping of the infield area. Phase IV was an ambitious long-range plan to include a regional recreation center to include a dance floor, banquet room, recreation area and administration capabilities. Sewer and water services were to be installed. Remember, these plans were envisioned in 1973. The world-class complex you enjoy today included all of the facilities proposed and more. All of this has been accomplished by the volunteers of the CPTC.
