


On behalf of our community, it is an honour and privilege to welcome everyone to Beausejour and to our Annual Canadian Power Toboggan Championships.

And to all the visitors and spectators, we hope that your stay in our community will be a most memorable one.







Also included in the program are pictures and write-ups on the 1966 Powder Puff Derby winner, Jean Grahn of Roseau, Minnesota, as well as the 1966 Player's Canadian Power Toboggan Champion, Steve Ave of Hurley, Wisconsin. Another page lists the previous winners from 1963 to 1966 in the Player's Canadian Power Toboggan Championship race, Cross Country Endurance race, Closed Course race, Cross Country B. and Powder Puff Derby.

The program also lists the racers entered in the various classes being run in the 1967 CPTC races. The Player's Canadian Championship had 31 entries, including 20 Polarises, 10 Ski-Doos, and 1 Snow Cruiser. The list was not complete, however, as some of the entries were not received before the race program was printed. One of those entries missing was Gerry Reese of Roseau, Minnesota, who went on to win the 1967 Canadian Power Toboggan Championship.





said he was going to do, and always did everything with a great big smile,





The Central North American Racing Association was formed in 1987 by a group of dedicated racers and organizers who were interested in creating a body to sanction ice oval snowmobile races. Currently, CNARA consists of President Bruce Modrzejewski, Secretary-Treasurer Jan Baker, and Directors Jamie Kines, Barry Klym, Ryan Keefe, Doug Thomasson, and Ken Day.

Basically the role of CNARA is to enforce ISR rules and to provide officials such as the race director, flagman, and tech director to help run the snowmobile races that it sanctions. CNARA also handles the registration of all racers, collecting the race registration money, and doing the pay-out of prize money to all winners. CNARA also sends a designate to attend the annual ISR Rules Meeting held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in order to have input into the rules governing ice oval racing.

The Brokenhead Trail Blazers was established on March 9th, 1970 at Brokenhead, Manitoba. The founding nine members were all from the Beausejour/Brokenhead area and included:

Roy Kryschuk John Kryschuk Ed Molinski Don Froehlich Raymond Kryschuk Henry Saluk Allan Trombo Mike Chorney Herb Soluk

During the early years, the club members participated in local races and also organized races at the Crossroads General Store at Brokenhead. In March of 1971, the Brokenhead Club was present at the Canadian Power Toboggan Championships opening ceremonies, carrying a club banner around the track by snowmobile. The club also volunteered to carry the Lieutenant Governor and other dignitaries to the track for the opening ceremonies that year. During the 1970's, the club continued to hold races and also poker derbies in the Brokenhead area. In 1972, the club built a clubhouse near Ladywood to hold club meetings and events.

In 1980, the club made a bold move to relocate the clubhouse to property adjacent to the Mars Sand Hills. That same year, the club purchased its first trail groomer and started to groom trails within the Mars Sand Hills for recreational trails and for poker derbies. In 1981, the club expanded its trail network by opening a trail north to the Gull Lake area. Around that time, the club built its first warm up shelter on the trail north of the Brokenhead River. This hut was affectionately known as the "Plastic Shack".

The club's first trail groomer was a 1974 Alpine, pulling a Bombardier snowmobile trail groomer, which was the best and only groomer available in the early 1980's. Slowly, the grooming equipment would evolve into a Bombardier J-5, a Ski-Doo Alpine II in 1990, a Bombardier SV200 in 1993, a brand new Mogul Master trail groomer in 1994, a Bombardier SV252 in 2001 and most recently a Bombardier BR400+ in 2005.




